

PLUMBERS SHOW DANGER OF OPEN VAULT IN PARADE

Sanitation was taught by the plumbers' union with their float in the Labor Day parade.

In the front of the float was an old style open vault with a skull and cross bones on the door, showing the evils of the old style open vault from the spreading of typhoid fever by the visits of flies and the pollution of wells and cisterns. Back of the vault was a bench with a pail and tin basin, and the washtub used for the bath. In contrast to this on the rear of the float was the modern white bathroom with its sanitary equipment. It was an argument for the abolition of the open vault, as proof used by the housing experts.

The grocery clerks, for whom the shorter hours and Sunday closing movements are being conducted, have a new union which made a splendid showing in the parade.

Mother Jones in her speech at Oak Summit urged the working people to vote for Wilson, as she had in a Press interview.
