



**T**he annual Labor Day celebration will be held at the Gibson County fairgrounds in Princeton this weekend.

Activities include the 109th parade at 9 a.m., Monday.

Carnival rides and food booths will run each day, starting at 5 p.m., Friday, Sept. 1. Admission to the fairgrounds and parking will be free. Members of local labor unions that belong to the Labor Day Association can buy arm bands for \$6 for unlimited rides for the four days. Others can buy the arm bands for \$8. Rides run from noon to 10 p.m.
