# GRANITE COMPANY AWARDED CONTRACT CLARK MEMORIAL

FRENCH LICK, Ind., July 15.—(UP)—Vermont granite will be used in exterior construction of the George Rogers Clark Memorial at Vincennes, the Federal Memorial Commission decided as it let the bid for the monument to W. R. Heath Company, Greencastle. The Heath Company bid on the entire project was \$773,800.

Acceptance of the Heath bid, which was based on stansted granite, was in opposition to pleas of Indiana limestone interests. Sen. James Watson, Rep. Albert H. Vestal and Frederick Schortemeier, counsel for the Indiana Limestone Company, led the fight for the state product.
