While South Korean divisions with U.S. air and sea support battled for the second best port in the Allied beachhead, new strength poured into Korea for the eventful United Nations counter-offensive.

On the northern front some 20 miles northeast of Taegu, South Korean troops fell back under Communist pressure to positions around Hwabon-Dong, three miles south of Uihung. A Communist attack on the South Korean 8th division drove it back about a mile to the area of Imant, 18 miles northwest of Pohang and 20 miles east of Uihung.
